



Who we are...

Vivek-Uday Students' Welfare Society, a registered voluntary students' welfare organization, was started its journey in the year 2001 at Belgharia in Kolkata, West Bengal. It has been making an earnest effort to help meritorious students, who despite having intense socio-economic limitations, dream of higher education. Though in its early years, the Society feels glad for the boys it could be of assistance to. From supporting a few boys, to accommodating them, the society has grown in its own right over the years. Though this organization was initiated by some ex-students of *Ramakrishna Mission Calcutta Students' Home*, Belgharia, later on many other people from different places have become attached. The society is inspired by Swami Vivekananda's idea of "Man making education".

We are appealing to you, since you are in a position to empathize with the students who want to study, who need jobs to feed their families but are denied, all because of money. As you know, for higher education, costs have escalated rapidly and the institutes are still concentrated mainly in the urban areas. In this scenario, we lose plenty of bright minds and good men from rural areas, who quit studying after school. The following survey conducted by NSSO (National Sample Survey Organization) in the year 2004-05 reflects the huge loss of human resources resulting from denial of higher education.



You must have felt for the numerous teenagers forced to take up farming, labour works, works in small shops and peddling in trains and buses just because they, their families somehow have stayed neglected. We, who are now a little comfortable with our lives can look out to help the deprived, make little changes; give something back to them who in some trifle way have contributed to our present being. Your help means a lot to these families, these students who want to study further. One day you too would feel proud and happy in the success of these disadvantaged students.

Mission...

The primary aim of the society is to provide a home like atmosphere in a shelter where boys and girls from rural areas, who cannot afford to go for graduation due to financial shortcomings but are enthusiastic and admirable. The society also takes care of the expenses of the boys' and girls' viz. the college fees, books, tuitions etc. In addition to these, it has also been trying to develop a realistic sense of life and values in the students to become a good citizen. The Society also provides effective career guidance by bringing the aspirants in touch with the eminent professionals in their relevant field of study.

Vision...

At present, the society supports 11 students in a rented house at Belgharia in Kolkata. Our goal is to ensure a permanent residential place so that some more students can also be financially helped. This can only be possible with you help.

As more sponsorship comes our way, we could provide support to the higher secondary students too. Our society grows with you.

Journey so far...

- 14 We started by fully supporting a boy in 2004.
- In 2006 we shifted to a rented house with three new students. Two boys in 2007 and four more in 2008 led us to shift to a bigger rented house to accommodate all.
- +17 more students were admitted from 2009-12. In 2013 and 2014, we have taken in total eight new boys and with the successful passing out of previous students; we currently have 11 boys in all. Vivek- Uday has shifted to a new abode recently.
- ♣ Our story beams with many successes of our students, who would have quit study after higher secondary if not for Vivek Uday.



Activities...

- 1. Vratriboron: Apparently it is nothing different from an official fresher's welcome occasion. In reality it is far away from the usual series of legpulling and game shows, the fresher's welcome functions are popularly known as. In Vivek-Uday, it marks the beginning of an enlightened journey of these struggling young minds, for whom, the journey towards education has been littered with stones and pebbles of hardships. It is observed on 15th August every year and starts with students paying homage to Sri Ramakrishna, Maa Sarada and Swami Vivekananda. The seniors welcome the juniors in the august presence of Maharaj from Ramakrishna mission and many eminent educational personalities from renowned institutions. The society aims at making the event a launch pad for the youths for a bright future. Many academic as well as non-academic interactions take place between the students and the professors and teachers, which motivate them to tread the path lying ahead with unfailing enthusiasm and persistence. These students are kept in touch with these professionals throughout their career struggle so that they can reap the benefit of an expert guidance.
- 2. Cultural activity: Our students love to fill their recess time with music and poetry. Sagar and Animesh are the lead singers, supported efficiently in the instrumental part by others. Every year, on various special occasions like Bhasha Dibosh or Saraswati Pujo or Independence Day, we publish our wall-magazine 'Vivek-Uday'- the ultimate playground of creativity where freedom of spirit works at its best! Ranging from the confused cloud of ideals to the social, national and international doldrums hovering over our existence, ranging from the enigmatic fascination our nature offers upto the quirky alleys of love and romance, our Vivek Uday ouths have serious say in every field! The comic illustrations, which quite often touch upon the dangerous boundary of sarcasm, sometimes leave us wondering whether they have been created by the professionals! One of our students is soon going to publish a book of poetry under the pationals of the great poet Shankha Ghosh.

- **3. Excursion:** Once in a year we take the students on an outing for a refreshment of both the physical and mental health. Last year we ventured into the woods of Metala, a place in Bankura. The society also arranges education tour for our students to visit different places.
- 4. Bridge-the-gap: We believe there is a gaping hole between education and the prospects of education. The uniqueness of knowledge gathered in the under-graduation level is lost soon, leaving the education as a petty collection of curriculum and semesters and students soon lose the objectivity. To enliven this tryst with textbooks, we arrange for special talks by professors and research scholars in various fields. In these friendly exchanges, students come to know the scope and prospects awaiting them. Above all, in these hours they can learn a lot of things of their subjects from a new perspective and can clarify many fundamental conceptual doubts they are having while proceeding through their syllabus. The other way around is that, research scholars sometimes rediscover the magic of their subjects while handling the dicey queries of the inquisitive students.

5. Vivek-Uday library: Vivek-Uday has a personal library with a commendable collection of books (approximately 251), both text books and story books. The Society try to cover the text books as well as reference books as per requirements of the existing Hons. Students and effectively it includes most of the subjects in science and arts stream. Apart from text books, our library can boast of a variety of story books that provide food-for-thought (67 total), to name a few: A Brief History of Time, Rabindra-rachanabali, Galpoguchho, Sarat-samagro, Sukanta-samagra, Bankim-samagra, Sukumar-smagra, Aloukik noi loukik, Lila-prasango, Karmojyog, Gita, Vivekananda's Patrabali, Sri-Ramkrishna ke je rupe dekhiyachi, Swami shishyo sangbad etc.

Future Plans...

- ♣ A permanent residential place equipped with all necessary facilities for the students.
- ↓ A larger place is needed since we want to house more needy students. Our goal is to make a provision for about 100 students by the year of 2020.
- ↓ We want to increase the number of girls' fellowship and arrange a place for girls to reside permanently and study for graduation.
- ↓ To make the Vivek-Uday library bigger and to make the membership of the library more general.
- ↓ To provide the school students with financial help in the form of scholarship.
- ↓ Social activities in the slums around Vivek- Uday, Belgharia.


